Oncosperma horridum (Griff.) Scheff. Arecaceae. CN: [Malay -Bayas], Mountain nibong palm. Indigenous to Indo-China and Malesia ecozone and found growing wild in lowland forests. Big clump, monoecious, stem reaching 20 m'; all plant parts spiny; pinnate leaf, straight and drooping at end, 2-3 m. leaflets lanceolate, petiole 1-2 m with short spathe, Inflorescence yellow, fruit oval 2cm diam., green changing brown and black when ripe.
